Incoming Case with Foreign Court Order

Do we have Jurisdiction to enforce? (5700.201, et seq)

By a Hague Central Authority

The Hague Convention requires an application made through a central authority [5700.701(1)]. So even if a Hague order, Hague rules do not apply.
