Domestic violence by the numbers

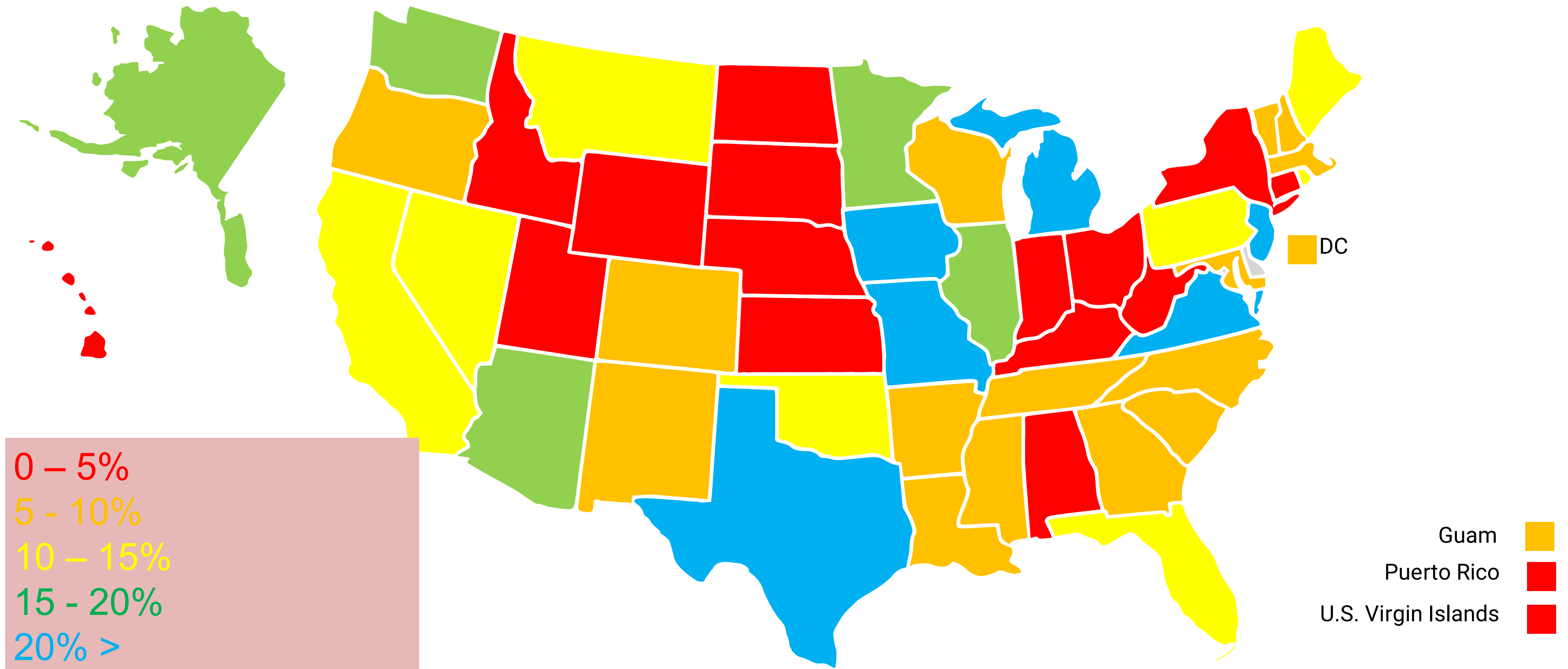
- 24 people per minute are victims of rape, physical violence or stalking by an intimate partner in the US.
- 1 in 4 women and 1 in 7 men aged 18 and older in the US have been the victim of physical violence by an intimate partner.
- 15 million children in homes where DV takes place – annually in the U. S.
- 1691 women in the U.S. killed by intimate partners in 2021



Domestic violence, and child support, by the numbers

- 4 out of 10 custodial parents report domestic violence with the other parent on their case
- 8 out of 10 survivor parents report staying with or returning to an abuser because of financial insecurity
- 4 out of 10 victims of DV homicide in one state had open child support cases (2022)
- 1 in 10 custodial parents have their case flagged with a family violence indicator (nationally)

Agreements/guidance

- Take care of yourself

- We are learning at the speed of trust



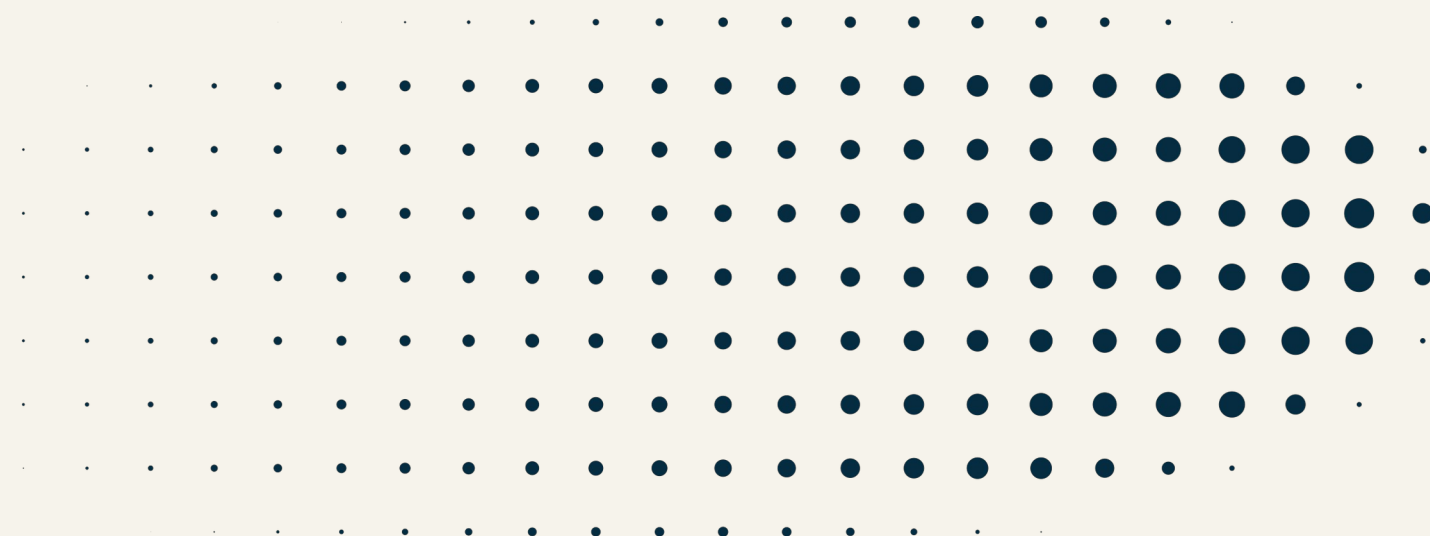
