

Sample Medical Coverage Wording

A. Medical Coverage:

- () Obligor has medical insurance that is affordable and accessible to the child(ren) and is ordered to provide it until further order of the Court.
- () If, at any time, private medical insurance stops, Obligor shall pay \$_____ per month for cash medical support beginning upon notice by either party or the employer to the Court or to DCSS, that insurance has been discontinued.
- () Obligee will provide medical insurance that is affordable and accessible to the child(ren). This requirement may be satisfied by either public or private insurance.
- () Other findings related to medical support:

Medical expenses not covered by Insurance

All medical/dental expenses, including co-pays, that are not covered by insurance and are greater than any amount ordered to be paid by Obligor as a cash medical payment, shall be shared between the parties as follows: Obligor is responsible for _____% and Obligee is responsible for _____% of medical expenses.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PERSON PROVIDING INSURANCE: If you are ordered to provide private medical insurance, you must send the name of the insurance plan and the policy or group number(s) within ninety (90) days to:

If you do not provide this information, DCSS may send a Medical Support Notice to Withhold to your employer. This could result in you being charged twice for insurance or being charged for cash medical support when insurance is already being provided.

You must also provide an insurance card to the other parent and notify the other parent, and DCSS, at the address above, if coverage is no longer being provided for the child(ren).
